ANALYSIS OF UNIVERSITY SERVICES (IRO + SS) BENEFITS FROM THE POINT OF VIEW OF IROS AND SS



- Non-prescriptive practices that involve different entities to address common problems in a line of work.








Our dual career enviroment

Tallinn University of Technology (TalTech) is committed to supporting students in pursuing dual careers, particularly those balancing academic studies with high-level sports. Recognizing the challenges faced by student-athletes, TalTech has initiated a scholarship program aimed at assisting students engaged in elite sports. This initiative seeks to alleviate financial burdens, enabling students to excel both academically and athletically. For instance, Susannah Kaul, a Paralympic swimmer and architecture student at TalTech, manages a rigorous schedule of early morning swim practices, gym sessions, work commitments, and lectures. She emphasizes the importance of financial support in maintaining this balance, stating that without it, she would have to choose between her passions. Similarly, Juuso Roihu, a business student and competitive sailor, spends significant time training abroad due to Estonia's short sailing season. The costs associated with equipment upgrades and travel are substantial, and scholarships play a crucial role in supporting his dual career aspirations. TalTech's dual career support extends beyond financial assistance. The university collaborates with industry partners to offer work-based learning opportunities, such as internships with companies like Pipedrive. These programs provide students with practical experience, enhancing their readiness for future employment. TalTech Additionally, TalTech encourages student initiatives by offering funding for various projects, promoting a well-rounded university experience. Through these comprehensive support systems, TalTech ensures that students can effectively manage dual career paths, combining academic success with professional and personal development.

What is a high level athlete in France?

Registration on the ministerial list
There are 4 different categories included in the Elite athlete list, which provide rights and
prerogatives

(European, World and Olympic Games)
Elite athletes,
Senior athletes,
New generation athletes,
Retired athletes.

These categories are very important because the French Ministry support all this athletes in other case the aids are not the same (for youngest and athletes who are not in these lists)



The courses

The institute has developed a range of initial and continuous training courses suited to meet the needs and constraints of those involved in elite sport.

→ This includes courses that lead to qualifications, customized programs, vocational training days, conference sessions and professional support.

The training programs, with around 30 pathways currently available at INSEP or in institutions that have signed agreements with INSEP, are adapted to the schedules of elite athletes.

Classes are provided on site and/or as distance learning depending on athletes' availability.

INSEP signed partnership with:

- Sorbonne University
- National Conservatory of Arts
- National School of Physical Therapy and Rehabilitation
- University Institute of Technology in Créteil

Nearly 190 athletes took part in external study courses outside the walls of INSEP, with a growing variety of training options (hotel business, IT, banking/insurance, construction and public works, arts and entertainment, etc.).



How INSEP supports future Olympic champions through their 360° project: sports, life and studies?

Young athletes already possess great maturity, team spirit and competition that they put to work in their training program.

→ They develop skills of which they are not necessarily aware.

By accompanying them in their life project, and their professional project from their arrival at INSEP, we also contribute to their sports emergence, because all three are connected

Each project is completely individualized

Find a balance in the imbalance



The need for some high-level athletes to reconcile sport performance and studies

To be accompanied in their long or very long-term projects

The need to put in square **specific and individualized course and schedule arrangements** for very unique high-level athletes,

according to their own time frame



RETRAINING AND CAREER CHANGE

Preparations for the end of a career start far upstream, at least one year before the planned end date.

INSEP's Elite Athlete Training and Support unit works closely with INSEP's Psychology unit to offer the opportunity for an end-of-career psychological assessment for each athlete who requests this.

As part of their employment, retraining or career change support measures, current or former elite athletes are given an interview to help them with their professional integration steps.

Developing skills assessments and transition support (coaching, mentoring, self-confidence exercises, etc.).

Athletes are offered work placements, internships or job opportunities when this can help them with their career development plans.





Knowledge of the Dual Career Phenomenon

• Research on dual career is crucial to highlight actual situation, problems, needs, support, key determinants, and positive effects of policies and programmes in different sport and educational context at local and

international level.



Difficulty in generalizing findings due to **confounding factors** (e.g., gender, age, type and sport experience, academic major and level, socioeconomic, contextual, organizational and policies at local, national, and international levels

The Bengt Nybelius Scholarship

Requirements: submit <u>as first author</u> an original and unpublished manuscript related to the scope of EAS

Starting from 2024, CIP guarantees the employment, the salary, and the social security of elite Italian employee-paralympic athletes of the public or the private sectors when needing a sport-leave (max 90 days/year and max 30 continuous days) by reimbursing the respective employers who request it, within the limits of €1,000,000/year
